So-called gig companies like Uber, Lyft and DoorDash treat their drivers as freelance contractors, instead of employees. That gives workers more flexibility on when they work, but also means they get no minimum wage or benefits, and must pay for their own vehicles and expenses. The passage of Assembly Bill 5 and a recent court decision found that the gig workers should be classified as employees.
